Registration & payment deadline is May 16th!

THE CHALLENGE! 6th & 7th graders will be challenged to sacrifice a week of their summer to live together and serve God and our community as a team! Each day, students will serve (in teams of 8) at two local non-profit organizations. They'll have a lot of fun each night, eat lots of food, worship together, be challenged by a speaker, and get to know other students. We'll serve over 40 organizations in Sioux City like: the Gospel Mission, Boys Club, the Alzheimer's Association, Camp Goodwill, DOT Adopt a Highway, and Habitat for Humanity.

WHO? This mission trip is open to students finishing 6th & 7th grades.

WHEN & WHERE? Students need to be dropped off at Sunnybrook Community Church (5601 Sunnybrook Drive) on Sunday night, July 11th at 7:30 p.m. (Please have students eat dinner before they come!) They should be picked up on Thursday, July 15th at 5:00pm.

Deadline for Payment & Registration is Sunday, May 16

- ✦ Both a registration form and \$90 need to be turned in on May 16 or earlier to secure a spot! We have only 110 openings! It's first-come-first-serve.
- ✦ **REMEMBER!** We'll only let students participate if we have enough volunteer adults and vehicles. Your student could be turned away if we don't get the adults and vehicles needed. So, make sure to get your student registered as quickly as possible.
- ✦ Write checks out to your participating church.

DON'T BRING

- ✓ Cell phones (cell phones will be confiscated.)
- ✓ A bad attitude
- ✓ Valuables
- ✓ Tobacco or drugs, pop, candy, snacks
- ✓ CD players/ipods, game boy or any electronic device

DAILY SCHEDULE

Morning

- 6:30. Rise and Shine.
- 7:00. Student teams prepare breakfast & lunches & clean bathrooms by 7:00
- 8:00. Morning devotions, meet with teams.
- 8:30. Out the door to serve the city.

Evening.

- 4:30: Students return for showers and "hang time". Student teams prepare dinner.
- 5:30. Dinner.
- 6:30 – 8:00. FUN activity!

- 9:00. Split up by youth groups for small group discussion.
- 10:00. Lights out

CONDUCT CODE. Parents should discuss this with students!

We want to provide safe, positive experiences for everyone. In an effort to allow for this kind of atmosphere, the following rules and guidelines have been established by the "In Siouxland for Good" leadership team.

1. If there is a problem with a rule or a student's inappropriate behavior is reoccurring or can't be resolved, parents will be called to pick up students **immediately**. Final decisions on any disciplinary action will be made by the youth pastor and/or the adults directly supervising the youth.
2. All students are expected to sacrifice a week of sporting events, ball games, jobs, family functions and other trips. If a student cannot do that, we ask that the student does not attend this event. If the student leaves the event before the last day, that student may be asked not to return. Reasonable exceptions will be determined by ISFG staff.
3. Students are expected to bring all of the supplies listed on the previous page or go without them for the remaining week. In order to make this week be a true mission experience, we won't allow students to call home to ask parents to drop off any of the above items (or extra items) during the week.
4. There will be no use of tobacco, alcohol, illegal drugs or any similar substance. If this rule is broken in any way, parents will be called to immediately pick up their student.
5. Kissing, snuggling, and other intimate displays of affection are prohibited. Boyfriends and girlfriends who attend together must act in an honorable manner during the entire event. At no time is any youth allowed into the sleeping area of the opposite gender.
6. Students are expected to maintain positive attitudes and act in a way that respects and honors others. Teasing, bullying, etc. will not be permitted and will be dealt with. Students engaged in such will be asked to leave.

To be read and signed by Parent/Legal Guardian: As parent/legal guardian, I hereby give permission for my child to participate in "In Siouland For Good" July 11-15, 2010 I understand that the "In Siouland For Good" organizers, partnering churches do not carry medical and hospitalization coverage for my child. I understand that my personal medical and hospitalization insurance policies will provide primary coverage.

I further understand that in the event my child requires medical or dental treatment while engaged in the activity, reasonable efforts will be made to contact me. However, if I cannot be reached I hereby give consent and permission to my youth director or any adult organizer or volunteer acting on behalf of "In Siouland For Good" with respect to the activity, as agent for me, to administer or dispense: over the counter medications for the relief of minor aches, abrasions, cuts, or irritations, and consent to any x-ray, examination, injections, anesthesia, medical, dental, or surgical diagnosis and treatment and hospital care and treatment advised and supervised by a licensed physician, surgeon, or dentist (as appropriate) licensed to lawfully practice in the State where the services are rendered; either as an outpatient or by any hospital. To the best of my knowledge I have listed, above, all of my child's known allergies, medications and prescriptions to be taken, medical conditions and other pertinent information.

I agree to pay any and all expenses for my child being sent home, or I'll come get myself, if such disciplinary action is deemed necessary by the "In Siouland for Good" organizers or volunteers. I agree that if my child shares any information about physical or emotional behavior or any condition that, in the opinion of "In Siouland for Good" leadership, may be harmful to them, I, as a parent or legal guardian, may be informed.
